UPDATE



BURGLARY

In the month of *July 2020* there have been **eleven** residential burglaries and **one** attempted burglary. In *August 2020* there were **two** residential burglaries.

During lockdown crime was low in regards to burglary as well documented. The lockdown period coincided with the majority of people spending long periods at home. As measures have eased and people have returned to work and or gone on holidays once again, crime has spiked.

For balance and understanding of the ward crime figures historically, *July & August 2019* we recorded **nine** residential burglaries and **two** attempted burglaries. *July & August 2018* was exactly the same. That's an increase of 21% but in reality an increase of **three** offences on 'normal' years.

The team have been making use of our analytically based 'predictive mapping' tool which gives officers burglary focused targeted patrols based on intel on our systems. We also apply our local knowledge of hotspots and vulnerable residents we're aware of to bear in mind for patrols.

MOTROR VEHICLE CRIME

Since July 1st 2020 Coombe Hill has had:

- Five theft from motor vehicles
- Four theft of motor vehicles
- Two vehicle interference offences

Mid-August PC Stamp alongside assistance from officers from Grove and Tudor wards arrested two males for vehicle interference and possession of cannabis. The team have also recovered a stolen motorcycle within hours of being stolen. The victim was very happy and relieved to get back his property. PC Stamp and Tudor DWO PC Walker also seized a moped on false plates, which likely would've been used in crime.
